**Preamble**

The Rainy River District Social Services Administration Board (RRDSSAB) is responsible for defining which consumer results are to be achieved, for whom, and at what cost. Written with a long-term perspective, these mission-related policies embody most of the Board's part of long-range planning and ensure that the organization produces economically justifiable, properly chosen, well-targeted results.

**Policy**

The Board will establish End Targets for each of its program and services relating to:

- a) Consumer results to be achieved, i.e. "What good";
- b) "For whom"; and
- c) "At what cost."

RRDSSAB establishes end targets as part of its long-range planning. These targets are reviewed as part of the annual service or business planning process and revised, if necessary.
