Purpose

The Rainy River District Social Services Administration Board (RRDSSAB) must ensure that ambulance bases are maintained in a safe, clean and sanitary manner.

Policy

The Chief of Paramedic Services (PS) or designate ensures that Paramedics are instructed on how to appropriately vent the vehicle bays to maintain a safe and healthy work environment.

Procedure

Atikokan Base, Fort Frances Base, Emo Base, Rainy River Base

- When ventilation levels are not within acceptable limits in the vehicle bays, ventilation fans and intake air dampers automatically operate and an alarm sounds.
- 2. If the alarm sounds the area is to be immediately evacuated.
- 3. Paramedics may open the bay doors to assist in clearing the alarm in a shorter period of time.
- 4. The alarm will automatically cease when the ventilation levels drop to acceptable limits.
- 5. Employees may re-enter the area safely once the alarm has ceased. Should the alarm fail to clear, employees must contact the Duty Officer.
